2. Review of actions from previous meeting minutes	Minutes from last meeting could not be found at this time.	
3. KM presenting about the SEND and AP Improvement Plan from the Department for Education	Presentation: Barnet is leading 1 of the 9 CPPs which includes Camden, Islington and Enfield Number of areas in focus including: national standards to increase consistency; establishing SEND and Alternative Provision (AP) partnerships – what is available and how it will be commissioned; introduction of standardised EHCP and digitising the process; providing tailored lists to parents of of suitable placements; improving staff training e.g. 'Early Years SENCOs' (must remember our secondary schools); a tiered approach to PRUs; inclusion dashboards for all boroughs nationally; new framework for banding/level of funding; transitions to adulthood; improving targeted and universal support for children with SLCN. Barnet is ahead in some areas e.g. TA deployment. There will be a new EHCP Proforma and various Task and finish groups.  Questions:  NDCS JW asked re low incidence high need deaf population how does KM see CHSWG supporting this work and parental involvement going forward? E.g. parent carer forums. Task finish group representation. Barent parent carer forum has over 400 parents involved now and are very responsive. Anita can get representatives and bring ideas back to CSHWG.  JM reported Barnet SLT team have now got a band 7 to support this work but recruiting for ITAs. This will take time.	
4. Service Updates	KW Summerside is growing, there's a couple of children on the horizon	

KP emailed re Hendon – no changes since last meeting

Lisa emailed re NBHSP

RB – UCLH currently quiet on Barnet front, but BAU continues. AB thanked RB and said UCLH relationship is very efficient and they provide helpful reports – all agreed.

EAE Naomi returning to SLT after mat leave in May. Thanks to Caroline for covering the past 10-11 months. Hearing support pathway are now accepting children with mild to moderate or unilateral sensorineural deafness. Accepted first unilateral-profound.

MD – new Audiology manager Lina starting in April

AB – Barnet peripatetic TOD team losing sensory technician. Looking for a TOD with a responsibility for Audiology. Baby group doing well but would like to expand numbers so trying to launch a BSL singing group (targeted). Starting a youth group for age 8-13.

## 5. AOB

KW struggling with nursery pathway at the moment. Assessment places with Barnet funding while applying for EHCP is not allowed anymore. So no clear pathway or funding stream – less funding than needed. Causing delays to children accessing specialist nursery places. Does anyone have ideas? Waiting for panel delays start dates in nursery. JW said she would pick up with her colleagues as NDCS attend 136 CHSWGs.

YM suggested CHSWG meeting once a term with a more focused approach, rather than twice a term. DT said we could vote and suggested maybe a guest speaker for people who want to attend. JW raised what do we do with meetings, action plan discussed but not sure where its got to. Better to focus on 1-2 things and maintain momentum. Parents will get discouraged if their involvement doesn't achieve anything.
